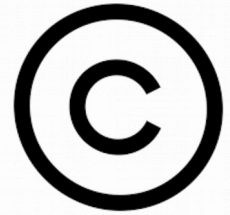

Do you have copyright for your publication?

- Review your copyright transfer agreement
- Ask your editor
- Check the journal publisher policy on [SHERPA/RoMEO](#)
- Check the publisher's website
- Request permission to self-archive from the copyright holder
- Ask the librarian repository@dias.ie



What is the correct version to submit?

Most journal publishers will not allow archiving of the published version
But will allow archiving of the **accepted version**.

Accepted version = the author's version after peer review edits have been incorporated but before any copy editing, branding or formatting changes have been incorporated.
It is best to submit the the accepted version.

Publishers policy of self-archiving

While journal publishers usually ask authors to assign copyright to them, many now allow self-archiving of post-prints (post-refereed version of the work) in an institutional repository; others may grant clearance if a direct request is made.

We strongly advise clarifying the publisher's policy of self-archiving before submitting your article for peer review.
